

Board of Supervisors Minutes
February 22, 2022

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 9:30 a.m. February 22, 2022. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Larry Vest; 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson.

Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Vest to approve the minutes of the February 14th regular meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried

The Board met with Lyle Brehm, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report

The Supervisors met with Duane Leek, Toledo, to discuss a possible abatement of taxes on Parcel 14-15-401-012. This property has past due taxes with penalties and interest, City of Toledo Special Assessments and Tama County Tax Certificate #14-0195 on it totaling \$6,191.00. He has spoken with the City of Toledo and upon him purchasing the property they have agreed to abate the special assessments. He is asking the Supervisors if they would agree to abate the taxes and tax sale certificate down to \$1,200 if he purchases the property. The Supervisors agree that it would be good to get the parcel back on the paid tax roll. Motion by Vest, seconded by Faircloth to abate the taxes, penalty, interest and tax certificate on Parcel 14-15-401-012 down to \$1,200 once purchased by Duane Leek, Toledo. All voted aye. Motion carried.

At 10:00 the Board held the first reading of proposed Ordinance #V.7 Tama County Weed Control Ordinance. Copies of the new proposed ordinance can be obtained in the Tama County Auditor's Office, 104 West State Street Toledo. There were no public comments. The hearing/reading was closed at 10:01 am. Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Vest to approve the 1st reading of proposed Ordinance #V.7 Tama County Weed Control Ordinance. All voted aye. Motion carried. The next hearing/reading is Monday February 28th at 10:00 am in the Supervisors meeting room.

Motion by Vest, seconded by Faircloth to approve the claims for payment as presented. All voted aye. Motion carried.
