The Supervisors met with Taveis Stevens, Zoning Administrator, and Dan Hart from New Century FS to discuss a new storage facility site north of Toledo one mile east of Highway 63 and Van Wall Equipment. It will be used only for storage only, no production. New Century Farm Service is moving storage of hazmat materials out of cities. This was approved previously by Zoning in May and Mr. Hart wanted to present this to the Supervisors and the public so they will know what is going up at the site. The 911 Director, Sheriff and local fire department have all been notified of this new facility. The Supervisors will review and take action on it at next week's meeting.

The Board met with Ben Daleske, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report. He presented the Roof Warranty on the new county shed. The Supervisors will look it over and put it on the agenda next week for action.
