

Board of Supervisors Minutes
March 11, 2024

The Tama County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. March 11, 2024. Present: 1st District Supervisor, Curt Hilmer; 2nd District Supervisor, Bill Faircloth and 3rd District Supervisor, Dan Anderson.

8:30 – 9:15 Employee/Department Head Time

9:15 – 9:30 Present: Supervisors Hilmer, Faircloth, Anderson. Assistant Auditor Karen Rohrs, members of the public. Deputy Sheriff Killian was also present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Public Comment on Agenda Items: None

9:30 Meeting called to order. Motion by Anderson, seconded by Faircloth to approve the minutes of the March 4th regular meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried

The Board met with Ben Daleske, Tama County Engineer, to get a road projects report. He asked the Supervisors to approve a purchase agreement and easement documents on purchasing additional right of way on E Avenue with Diana King & Karen Schnathorst. Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson, to approve a purchase agreement and easement documents for Project #BROS-CO86(109)- - 8J-86 with Diana King and Karen Schnathorst. All voted aye. Motion carried.

The board also discussed placing speed signs and school signs on C Ave due to the Amish Community wanting to build a school near a rock quarry. Ben stated that school zones are usually in town and that he needs to do more research. Ben will come back to the board next week with more information.

Tammy Wise, HR/Insurance Administrator, presented an updated Tama County Credit Card Policy. Motion by Anderson, seconded by Faircloth to approve the updated Tama County Credit Card Policy. All voted aye. Motion carried. A copy is available in the Tama County Auditor's Office.

Last week the Supervisors set up dates to discuss declaring EMS an essential service. Due to publication issues the Auditor is asking them to reset the meeting dates to allow for proper publication time. Motion by Faircloth, seconded by Anderson to set up meetings to authorize a resolution declaring EMS an essential service in Tama County. These meetings will be Monday May 13th, Tuesday May 14th and Monday May 20th at 9:45 am in the Supervisors meeting room. All voted aye. Motion carried.
