The Tama County Emergency Management Commission Board meeting was called to order at 7:35PM on April 10, 2012. Board Members present: Kendall Jordan (Board of Supervisors), Roger Ochs & Kurt Kelley (Chelsea), Arlene Vondracek (Clutier), Steve Weekley (Dysart), Keith Sash (Gladbrook), Steve Mahr (Lincoln), Dennis Kucera (Sheriff), Mike Skopec & Carol Waltemate (Traer), and Ryan Currens & Julie Vokoun (Emergency Management). Members of the public present: Jim Currens, Rob Schrader, Bob Vokoun, and Jim Shutts.

Motion by Vondracek, second by Mahr to approve the agenda. All aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Skopec, second by Sash to approve the March EMA Commission Executive Board meeting minutes. All aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Mahr, second by Ochs to approve the claims for payment. All aye. Motion carried.

Ryan gave the monthly EMA Activity Report.

A discussion ensued regarding a request for mileage compensation to any Board member for any meeting attended. Weekley suggested members check with their city for approval and compensation to attend non-required meetings. Motion by Mahr to pay mileage to Executive Board members attending all meetings and Primary voting Board members attending Full Board meetings, second by Sash. All aye. Motion carried.

Ryan advised the Board that the CodeRED contract was up for renewal. He contacted them regarding the possibility of a lower cost option. He also advised that he had checked with another mass notification company, Everbridge. Their services were comparable or better than what CodeRED provided for about the same cost. Motion by Kucera to continue the contract with CodeRED at the less minutes/less money proposal and research Everbridge for future use, second by Sash. All aye. Motion carried. Kucera will also follow-up on 2011-2012 governments that have not yet paid for CodeRED service.

Ryan requested Board approval to stage 2 hazardous material overpack drums at 2 locations in the County to make them more accessible if needed for an incident. Motion to stage overpack drums by Ochs, second by Skopec. All aye. Motion carried.

The next EMA Commission Executive board meeting will be held May 8th, 2012 following the 911 Service Board meeting.

Motion by Kucera, second by Mahr to adjourn at 8:15PM. All aye. Motion carried.
