and opportunities necessary for their children to be healthy, safe, and secure. Be ready to succeed in school, have

available affordable, high quality child care, and access to a preschool opportunity.

Tama County Empowerment has had several success stories this fiscal year. One that stands out is a 16 year old pregnant, Hispanic girl who had returned to her parent's home out of foster care when she was 7 months pregnant. She had minimal family support, no role modeling, and no parenting skills. She was referred by DHS for Tama County Healthy Families' education, support and referrals. Empowerment was able to connect her with the South Tama Co. Alternative High School where she will graduate this year. She was connected to Tama Co. Healthy Family's Parents as Teachers Program. She qualified for and has participated in the WIC program and the Stork's Nest education and support program. With our help, she took a driver's education program and was able to get a drivers license. Her daughter was born on 6-10-08, healthy and thriving. Providers were all very impressed with her desire to learn and be a good parent. She quite often was reading materials presented to her before we walked out the door. She had many obstacles to overcome and has shown huge growth in personal and parenting skills. She was connected with Work Force Investment Summer Youth Program and was hired by the Tama Public Library for a summer job. She has applied and been accepted into the Certified Nurse Assistant Program for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. This is just one example of Empowerment's collaborative efforts that made a difference in this family's life.




# How to me messare our progress?

### How are we doing?

- ♦ Incidence of Founded Child Abuse—the State of Iowa has seen an increase in founded child abuse from FY 07 to FY 08, yet Tama County remained below the state percentage, when in 2006, Tama County was above the state average.
- Providers in QRS Plan—the number of licensed/registered child care providers have remained the same, yet the number of providers participating in the QRS (Quality Rating System) has increased by 167%.

### What can you do to help?

- Leave funding decisions locally based on our individual county's needs.
- ♦ Leave access/support for services in Tama county so clients/families don't have to drive 40 miles to access services.
- Partner and collaborate with Tama County Empowerment Board to assure children in Tama County are receiving adequate services to make sure they are healthy, ready to succeed in school and have a safe, secure, nurturing family and quality childcare environment.
- ♦ Contact your local legislators and let them know how much you appreciate and value Empowerment's services
- ♦ Contact Child Care Resource and Referral for questions regarding local quality childcare providers and support them.
