



Otter Creek Lake and Park is just the place if you are looking for a scenic park with rolling hills, sixty-five acre lake and camp sites in a relaxing environment. The facility is located nine minutes Northeast of Toledo, Iowa.

We do not have the ability to reserve camp sites. **All our camp sites are offered on a first come, first served basis.** The park boasts sixty-five RV sites with electricity and 18 tent sites. A dump station for the RV units is provided near the boat ramp area. Water hydrants are scattered throughout the campgrounds.

Other amenities at the park include a shower-house, boat ramp, shelter houses, two small playgrounds, restrooms, picnic areas, small beach and three mile circular hiking trail.
